Introduction

This workshop is designed for the planning of urban landscape networks in an attempt to have nature areas integrated into traditional urban land-use planning. The biophysical and socio-economic benefits of such a network will be discussed to provide justification for this incorporation. The workshop will focus on building upon ecological planning processes and incorporating theory and methodology from landscape ecology. The workshop includes an assessment of natural and cultural resources, formulating the spatial structure of the network and examination of network components using Kandy Urban Landscape as an example. The workshop will cover following tasks,

- Overview of the workshop and Principles of Urban Ecological Planning
- Field-based Practical
- Analyzing status of the city
- Findings, discussions and suggestions for Strengthening existing Kandy City Plan
